What/Where is the South River Forest?

South Atlanta's most valuable natural resource, the South River, flows eastwardly across Atlanta and through the SRF on its way to Jackson Lake and the Ocmulgee River. The SRF is a crucial part of the river's urban watershed, the health of which impacts nature and communities on a regional scale.

Atlanta Dept. of City Planning, The Nature Conservancy and others have presented the SRF concept — an emerald necklace of connected greenspaces that will celebrate and protect the South River watershed and bring connectivity to SE metro Atlanta.



SOUTH RIVER FOREST:#1 SKYHAVEN QUARRY

- Owned by developer. Plans submitted by owner to EACA LUZ Committee 12.2020 would rezone for 156 units inc. vehicular bridge over threatened creek.
- Western boundary on Moreland
- 10 Acres; wooded, granite quarry
- Ripplewater/Intrenchment Creek
- Wildlife habitat and corridor
- Adjacent to Skyhaven (#2)
- Potential "greenway corridor"
 (following the creek south) could connect to Moreland Bridge Park
 (#3); Proposed in <u>ARC's 2008 LCI:</u>
 <u>South Moreland Avenue Study</u>

SOUTH RIVER FOREST: #2 SKYHAVEN

- Former elementary school; Property of DeKalb Public Schools
- 14 acres, cleared & wooded; Prime for mixed-use greenspace, community center, pool, affordable housing (cluster design), dog park, etc.
- Headwater stream flows through; metal footbridge connects dead end streets
- Adjacent to Skyhaven Quarry (#1)
- Amphibian & wildlife habitat/corridor
- Highest residential density of all sites
- Neighbors use it as a park but it is unprotected
- Skyhaven is beloved; there is a community effort to protect the property called "Saving Sky Haven"







#3 Moreland Bridge Park

- Proposed in <u>ARC's 2008 LCI: South Moreland Avenue Study</u> (image below, pg 4:15)
- PATH's South River Trail could pass under Moreland along Entrenchment Creek and connect to the Beltline
- ~5 Acres; Wetland/floodplain restoration needed (educational opportunity)




SOUTH RIVER FOREST:#5 South Moreland Landfills Google map link here

View northwest of Atlanta




#6 Water Treatment Plant Woods & Cemetery

- City of Atlanta Property
- Approximately 40 acres
- Frontage on Intrenchment Creek
- Hilltop-to-Creek
- Isolated Cemetery: ca. 1850-present
- Across the street from McNair High School (Bouldercrest Rd.)
- Adjacent to Old Prison Farm
- Likely PATH Route




#7 Old Prison Farm, "Honor Farm"

- Structures from WWI era through 1950's
- Dairy foundation ruins
- Warden's House, Worker
 Homes
- 3 ponds
- Carnegie stones
- 4 miles of trails
- Intrenchment Creek frontage
- Significant wildlife habitat



#8 Intrenchment Creek Park

- Under immediate threat. Learn more at <u>StopTheSwap.orq</u>
- DeKalb County public greenspace
- 120 Acres
- Upland, floodplain, urban forest
- Critical greenspace frontage & buffer for Intrenchment Creek
- Land swap of 40 acres of ICP to private developer approved by DK Board of Commissioners, 10/2020
- PATH South River Trail & Trailhead; trail connects to Gresham Park and continues east to GSU Perimeter Campus. PATH Foundation plans to connect as far east as The Monastery of the Holy Spirit, Conyers



#8 Intrenchment Creek Park

IMMEDIATE THREAT: DeKalb County land swap of ICP to Blackhall Studios

INTRENCHMENT CREEK PARK: Urban forest, important wildlife habitat & the Atlanta RC Airclub airfield.



BLACKHALL STUDIO'S PROPERTY: DeKalb will receive clear-cut wasteland, floodplain, and fragmented land along Bouldercrest Rd. in exchange for ICP.

- Full size gymnasium
- Public pool
- Basketball Courts

- Nature Trail
- 100+ acres of forest

- 18 Hole public golf course
- 10 Hard tennis courts
- 4 Clay tennis courts
- Driving range
- Leagues & lessons
- Where Sugar Creek meets the South River





#11 Soapstone Ridge

- Broad geologic area
- Mostly privately owned
- Archeological site, Muskogee-Creek
- 19th century farm ruins
- Wetlands
- South River Corridor
- Extensive illegal clearcutting along the South River by Crown Enterprises, 2019






#12 Constitution Lakes

- DeKalb County public greenspace
- 200 Acres
- Wetland, ponds, boardwalk, soft trails
- Doll's Head Trail
- Significant bird & wildlife habitat



SOUTH RIVER FOREST: #13 Lake Charlotte

- City of Atlanta purchased in 2020
- To be restored for public use and passive greenspace
- 216 Acres


Intersection of Hutchens Road and King Smith Road in the South River Gardens neighborhood.
